## Quilt Entry Form Instructions

QUILT ENTRY DEADLINE JULY 18, 2025

This year's Quilt Fest is a **challenge**—to quilters and quilt lovers alike—to "see" quilts differently!

Historically, quilts map place through stories told in fabric by everyday women, and the stories they tell are often overlooked or missing from written records. An individual quilt is a map of its maker's relationship with fabric, color, pattern, and skill at a single point in time. A collection of quilts—from a single quilter, a quilting guild, or an individual quilt collector—is a map of quilter's quild's or collector's fabric journey over time.

## ENTER YOUR QUILT NOW!

- A photo of the entire quilt must accompany each submitted entry form.
- Complete and submit all 3 pages of the Quilt Description and Story Form by the entry deadline. The
  information you provide will be used to make a program highlighting the role quilts play in everyday life.
- Priority will be given to entries with complete paperwork submitted by the entry deadline. Late entries, or entries with incomplete paperwork, run the risk of not being included in the program, or not being accepted for display at all.
