Create and **donate** an art piece for our silent auction held at Quilt Fest 2024 during Labor Day weekend (Fri. 8/30 & Sat. 8/31).

The Challenge Phrase: "Celebrating The Journey"

- Create an art piece that represents your exploration of the above challenge phrase.
- The concept of "journey" is open to the artist's interpretation. Your piece might celebrate a specific journey you've taken, a new artistic skill your are exploring, or any other way the concept of journey speaks to you as an artist.

To Enter the Challenge:

- STEP 1: Fill out the Registration Form and return it (mail or email) by Aug 2, 2024. This lets us know you are making a piece to donate to our auction, and allows us to do preliminary planning of display space.
- STEP 2: Create an art piece in your media of choice in response to the Challenge Phrase listed above.
- STEP3: Fill out the Art Piece Creator's Statement and submit it along with your completed art piece.
- STEP4: Submit finished art piece, along with your Art Piece Creator's Statement, no later than Aug 25, 2024 to CTQF by mail at address listed on the Creator's Statement, or in person at the Wanakena History Center, 21 Second St., between 11am-4pm on 8/24/24 or 8/25/24.
